2. The Content of summary information

Firstly, the thesis standardizes terminology in legal documents regulating intangible cultural heritage in the spirit of the 2003 Convention of which Vietnam is a member; consistently uses phrases of honor, the national list of intangible cultural heritage, the representative list of the intangible cultural heritage of humanity, etc., manifesting Vietnam's commitment when participating in International Convention is through basing on legal measures, the process to formulate legal documents and apply practices on the protection and promotion of intangible cultural heritage effectively in reality.

Secondly, the thesis proposes to perfect the concept and evaluation criteria for recognition of intangible cultural heritage in the Law on Cultural Heritage; clearly defines and legislates the form of expression of intangible cultural heritage; recognizes and protects the copyright of artisans holding the type of intangible cultural heritage;

Thirdly, depending on practical research, the thesis identifies "gaps" in the current legal system on the protection and promotion of intangible cultural heritage values like: overlapping, inconsistency in authority activities on intangible cultural heritage, inventory, ranking, making scientific records, planning and zoning, protection, embellishment and restoration of intangible cultural heritages still exist many shortcomings, the inspection, examination and handling of violations of the Law on intangible cultural heritage have not been clarified, making it difficult to determine the responsible people and the commensurate level of punishment;

Using the results of research on legal theory and practical application of the law on intangible cultural heritage, the thesis proposes solutions to improve the law and law enforcement activities on the protection and promotion of the value of intangible cultural heritage in accordance with current and future contexts.
